Alaska Cruise & America's Great West is a 17-day land and sea journey along America's west coast, starting with five-days of visits to Santa Monica, Hollywood, Sunset Boulevard, Santa Barbara and San Francisco, with a variety of guided tours and free time to explore each famous destination.

Guests then board the MS Carnival Luminosa to cruise through the North Pacific, enjoying two days of on-board relaxation before stopping at the Alaskan capital of Juneau, followed by visits to the historic Gold Rush town of Skagway, the dramatic scenery of the Tracy Arm Fjord, Alaska's first city of Ketchikan, and a final stop at Prince Rupert, British Columbia's 'City of Rainbows', before sailing back to San Francisco.
