After enjoying breakfast at a local homestay, guests continue to explore the island by a local tak-tak car, taking in the undisturbed beauty of Koh Prathong's mangrove-lined seas and thick natural savannahs, for a truly memorable safari adventure.

For those wanting to continue exploring the natural beauty of The Sarojin's surrounding area, the residence offers a range of excursions, from elephant and jungle canoe safaris in Khao Sok and pleat boat trips through Little Amazon to trekking through the local jungles.

Offering some traditional adrenaline adventures are The Sarojin's zip-lining and bamboo rafting experiences through Khao Lak Lamru National Park and the Tonepariwat Wildlife Sanctuary excursion, which sees guests explore the pristine tropical forest with all-terrain-vehicle rides and white water rafting.
