

Palm Springs to Welcome New Boutique Resort, Dive Palm Springs, This November

Rooms start from \$300 per night and the property will be available to hire for events, weddings, photoshoots and private buyouts with facilities to host up to 150 daytime guests and 28 overnight guests.
